Are there any problems with the collection that need help from your local group or Coordinator?	
Please detail the succession plan for the plant material, records and research	
Are there any issues the collection holder would like raised with the Plant Conservation Committee or National Office?	
Has the collection been open to the public? Please give an estimate of the number of visitors per year.
